


# System login & authorization (1)

## Step 1


### Apply for new applications

- › Existing IBL users will be automatically transferred to smartIBL.
- › New users must request the role in advance via the Supplier Portal under **Apply for new applications**




### Login to the system

- After the **approval** of your request by your **portal manager**, you can now open the application **EDI Quality** via the Supplier Portal



- If your user ID is missing additional supplier indices/locations, you can apply for further memberships under "My Profile", "My Organizations". Here, too, approval from the portal manager is required.


